OLD BUSINESS

Several housekeeping items regarding Basketball game management were discussed.

- The sportsmanship announcement should be read prior to each game
- Clarification of the Section ruling, drums, not part of an organized band are considered noisemakers. If part of the organized band they should only be played during time outs.
- Spectators should not be permitted to shoot on the floor during half time and after games.

Playoff committee Recommendations

- Cross Country establish divisional alignments to by percentage (1=20%, 2=25%. 3=25%, 4=30%).
- Football Add an additional automatic qualifier to each of the seven leagues that have had the most playoff success over the past three years.
- Team Tennis Add an additional qualifier from the SFL and Delta (boys and girls).
- Water Polo
 - o Add a third division.
 - o Allow three teams for each league with at least 6 teams.
 - Divide the qualifiers into three divisions based on enrollment (success rule)
 - o Play the first two rounds at home sites must be played in a deep water pool
 - Decide on a pool for CVC qualifiers
 - Play semifinals and finals at neutral site
- Girls Wrestling North and South Qualifying Tournaments, Section Tournament.
- Football, Volleyball, basketball, soccer and softball A league champion (outright or #1 seed) must play at or above the level of its league.
