NEW BUSINESS

The Athletic Directors concurred that language should be added to the Constitution which would allow the League to become involved in any situation, regardless of whether a formal protest is filed, which is unsportsmanlike, ejectable or school suspendable. Uncalled penalties would not be part of this proposal.

The following proposal will be brought forward to the January meeting of the Athletic Board as a first reading:

2.1 A protest/appeal must be filed on the CVC approved protest form with the Ethics Chair, League President and League Commissioner

within two (2) school days of the infraction. An action may be initiated by the league Commissioner and/or the Ethics Chair upon sufficient information to warrant league involvement.

2.8 If during any review of a situation, the Commissioner, the Ethics Chair or the committee appointed by the Ethics Chair discovers a violation(s), which is unsportsmanlike, electable or school suspendable, and not previously reported or acted upon, the committee may enforce a penalty for that action.
