

CAPITAL VALLEY CONFERENCE VOLLEYBALL BY-LAWS

**ADOPTED BY THE CVC ATHLETIC BOARD: April 19, 2010
LAST REVISED: January 21, 2016**

Section 1 - Starting Date, Contacts and Scrimmages

1.1 Refer to CIF Sac Joaquin Section Constitution and By-laws.

Section 2 - Official Rules

2.1 The official rule book shall be the National Federation of State High School Association rule book.

Section 3 - Official Ball

3.1 A high quality 18 panel volleyball with $\frac{1}{3}$ white with NFHS stamp.

Section 4 - Game Times

4.1 Game times shall be indicated on the officially adopted league schedule

Section 5 – Championship

5.1 The varsity team with the greatest number of wins in league competition shall be designated as League Champion.

5.1.1 In the event of a tie, all teams tied for the best records shall be recognized as League Champions.

5.2 No champion will be recognized below the varsity level.

Section 6 – Playoffs

6.1 The following procedure will be used to break ties for playoff seeding, in the order listed

6.1.1 Head-to-head match score within the tie.

6.1.2 Head-to-head set differential within the tie.

6.1.3 Head-to-head point differential within the tie.

6.1.4 Overall set win within the league

6.1.5 Coin Flip

Section 7 - Miscellaneous - Activity Specific

7.1 Freshman and ~~Sophomores~~ Junior varsity will play two (2) out of three (3) games, Varsity will play three (3) out of five (5) games

7.2 The home team shall supply warm-up balls for both teams.

7.3 Warm-ups begin after the officials have completed a pre-game conference with the coaches and captains.

7.3.1 Warm up times will be as follows:

20-minute Countdown

5 minutes shared time- stop clock at 15:00

6 minutes-Serving team on court- stop clock at 9:00

6 minutes- Receiving team on court- stop clock at 3:00

3 minutes- Announcements, National Anthem, and coaching time.

7.3.2 Line ups must be turned in prior to 2:00.

7.4 Ground rules for any specific court situation shall be with the consent of both coaches and officials.

Section 8 – All Conference Selection

8.1 Schools will be awarded positions on the All-Conference team in accordance to their finish in League competition. Each school will make their own determination as to who will be placed on the All-Conference team.

8.1.1 A total of twelve players will be selected.

8.1.2 The automatic and at large positions shall be as follows:

8.1.3 Coaches will select the At Large Position(s) through a ranking system. 1 for the best player numerically through the last player nominated. Coaches will rank their own players.

8.2 From the 12 Person All-Conference team, one most valuable player shall be selected using a ballot. Each school shall have one vote and may vote for their own candidate.

8.3 Each school will be awarded two Second Team awards.

8.4 No all-conference team shall be selected below the varsity level.

8.5 If a coach does not attend the end of the season meeting.

8.5.1 They may communicate with the League Coordinator- the names of the automatic qualifiers.

8.5.2 If a coach does not communicate names with League Coordinator, the school's All Conference positions will be placed in the At Large pool.

8.5.2.1 Coaches will select the At Large Positions through a ranking system.

8.5.2.2 Each school may nominate a number corresponding to the number of at large positions available.

8.5.2.3 If schools do not use all their automatic positions, those positions are added to the number of at large positions

8.5.2.4 Coaches will rank every player nominated starting from 1 for the best player numerically through the last player nominated. Coaches will rank their own players.

8.5.2.5 The Coordinator shall total the numbers. The players with the lowest numbers will be added to the All-Conference team.

8.5.2.6 In the event of a tie(s), coaches will vote.

8.5.2.6.1 If the vote does not break the tie, the tie breakers used for playoffs shall be applied.

8.5.2.6.2 If the tie breakers do not break the tie a coin flip shall determine.

8.6 A ballot shall be taken to name the MVP. Each school shall have one vote to name the MVP from the automatic positions to be on the All-Conference team. A school may vote for its own candidate

8.7 Each school shall receive 2 Second Team Positions.

8.8 Total Awards: Twelve (12) Type of Award: Patch and certificate.

8.9 All conference selections shall be forwarded to the league commissioner ~~and the media.~~

8.10 In the event a coach does not attend the All conference meeting.

8.10.1 They may provide the coordinator with the names of the automatic qualifiers. Those students will be included on the All-Conference team.

8.10.2 They may send nominations for at large berths and special award consideration

8.10.3 They will not be able to participate in any vote taken at the meeting.

8.11 In the event a coach does not attend the meeting and does not forward the coordinator the names of the automatic qualifiers.

8.11.1 Those slots will be reserved for the school.

8.11.1.1 The name of the automatic qualifier will be added to the team when the league commissioner receives the name from the school.
