Proposed change to football by-laws.

Section 11 - Video Taping and Exchange

11.1 Equal press box facilities shall be provided for both schools for video tape personnel. Each school may have no more than two (2) persons in the video tape facility.

11.2 Member schools shall electronically transfer two varsity games or exchange two DVDs.

~~11.2.1 Sub varsity games are optional.~~

~~11.2.2 The games shall be the games played two and three weeks prior.~~

~~11.2.3 If, due to technical problems, the last two weeks cannot be exchanged, the school with the technical problem will exchange their two most recent games, the other school will exchange corresponding games.~~

~~11.2.4 Both coaches must agree if there is to be no exchange.~~

~~11.2.5 If one school fails to make an exchange, they will be required to play the game but will forfeit if the other school files a protest.~~

~~11.2 The home team shall provide electrical outlets on the sideline for visiting team's video equipment.~~ Item deleted from first reading

11.2 Each member school shall transfer, through Hudl or other electronic transfer platform, to every member school, a copy of the last two non-league games they play before starting league.

11.2.1 Each member schools shall send a copy of any non-league game they play during their bye.

11.3 For every CVC League game, the home school shall transfer, through Hudl or other electronic transfer platform, to every league school a copy of the video.

11.3.1 Transfer must be sent by 9:00 AM the morning following the game.

~~11.3.1.1 All copies must have been marked up with Offense, Defense and Kick game prior to sending.~~ Item deleted from first reading

11.4.1 No league member may send, exchange or provide in any manor a video containing another member school to any school outside the League. This includes films for post season competition. Schools may send a video which includes a member school if it occurs as an exchange with a school prior to a scheduled game with that school. Item added by amendment at March 30 Meeting.

11.4.1.1 Nothing in this section prevents schools from exchanging highlight films of individual players to colleges interested in recruiting players.

11.4.1.2 Nothing in this section prevents school from exchanging videos of non-league opponents.

11.4.1.3 Schools who fail to send their film by the deadline or do not send usable film, are subject to the following penalties:

- 1st Offense - Warning
- 2nd Offense - Removed from film pool for 2 weeks, no exchanges permitted.
- 3rd Offense - Barred from any further exchanges for a period of one calendar year.

11.5.1.4 Schools who violate the rule by exchanging league film with an outside school are banned from league film exchange for a period of one calendar year. A second and subsequent offense results in the school being fined \$50 in addition to being banned from the film pool.

Section 13 - All Conference Selection

Revised: August 19, 2015

13.2.2.1 Coaches will select the At Large Positions through a ranking system.

13.2.2.1.1 If a tie exists for any place in the league standings the total number of automatic qualifiers shall be added together and divided by the number of teams tied.

13.2.2.1.2 If the total number of automatic positions total does not come out even, at large positions shall be used bring the total to a number divisible by the number of teams tied.

13.2.2.1.3 The number of available at large positions shall be reduced by the number of positions used to adjust the ties.

Capital Valley Conference Volleyball Bylaw Amendment- 4/28/2022

Section 1- All Rules governed by C.I.F. regulations

Section 2- Game

2.1. Warm-ups begin after the officials have completed a pre-game conference with the coaches and captains.

2.2. Warm up times will be as follows

20 minute Countdown

5 minutes shared time- stop clock at 15:00

6 minutes-Serving team on court- stop clock at 9:00

6 minutes- Receiving team on court- stop clock at 3:00

3 minutes- Announcements, National Anthem, and coaching time.

Line ups must be turned in prior to 2:00.

2.3. Double Round Robin Schedule

2.4. Ground rules for any specific court shall be with the consent of both coaches and officials.

Official Ball

A high quality 18 panel volleyball with 1/3 white with NFHS stamp.

Section 4 Qualifying for Playoffs

4.1- The following procedure shall be used to break ties for playoff seeding only in the order as listed.

Head to match score within the tie.

Head to head set differential within the tie

Head to head point differential within the tie.

Overall set win in league

Coin flip

All conference Selections

5.1 A Most Valuable Player- A ballot shall be used. Each school shall have one vote to name MVP. Honored with a patch and certificate. A school may vote for its own candidate

5.2 12 First Team All Conference will be honored with a patch and certificate.

5.3 Schools will be awarded positions on the All Conference team in accordance to their finish in League competition. Each school will make their own determination as to who will be placed on the All Conference team.

- 5.4 Coaches will select the At Large Positions through a ranking system. 1 for the best player numerically through the last player nominated. Coaches will rank their own players.
- 5.5 Each school may nominate a number corresponding to the number of At Large Positions available.
- 5.6 If schools do not use all their automatic positions, those positions are added to the number of At Large positions.
- 5.7 Second Team - Each school will be awarded two.
- 5.8 If a coach does not attend the end of the season meeting.
- A. Coach must communicate with the League Coordinator- the names of the automatic qualifiers.
- B. If Coach does not communicate names with League Coordinator, the school's All Conference positions will be placed in the At large positions.
