CAPITAL VALLEY CONFERENCE VOLLEYBALL BY-LAWS

Section 1 - Starting Date, Contacts and Scrimmages

1.1Refer to CIF Sac Joaquin Section Constitution and By-laws.

Section 2 - Official Rules

2.1 The official rule book shall be the National Federation of State High School Association rule book.

Section 3 - Official Ball

3.1 A high quality 18 panel volleyball with $\frac{1}{3}$ white with NFHS stamp.

Section 4 - Game Times

4.1 Game times shall be indicated on the officially adopted league schedule

5ection 5 - Championship

- 5.1 The varsity team with the greatest number of wins in league competition shall be designated as League Champion.
 - 5.1.1 In the event of a tie, all teams tied for the best records shall be recognized as League Champions.
- 5.2 No champion will be recognized below the varsity level.

Section 6 - Playoffs

- 6.1 The following procedure will be used to break ties for playoff seeding, in the order listed
 - 6.1.1 Head-to-head match score within the tie.
 - 6.1.2 Head-to-head set differential within the tie.
 - 6.1.3 Head-to-head point differential within the tie.

- 6.1.4 Overall set win within the league
- 6.1.5 Coin Flip

Section 7 - Miscellaneous - Activity Specific

- 7.1 Freshman and Junior varsity will play two (2) out of three (3) games, Varsity will play three (3) out of five (5) games
- 7.2 The home team shall supply warm-up balls for both teams.
- 7.3 Warm-ups begin after the officials have completed a pre-game conference with the coaches and captains.
 - 7.3.1 Warm up times will be as follows:
 - 20-minute Countdown
 - 5 minutes shared time- stop clock at 15:00
 - 6 minutes-Serving team on court- stop clock at 9:00
 - 6 minutes- Receiving team on court- stop clock at 3:00
 - 3 minutes- Announcements, National Anthem, and coaching time.
 - 7.3.2 Line ups must be turned in prior to 2:00.
- 7.4 Ground rules for any specific court situation shall be with the consent of both coaches and officials.

Section 8 – All Conference Selection

- 8.1 Coaches will vote to select the top 12 players in the league for all conference.
 - 8.1.2 Coaches will be permitted to vote for their own players
 - 8.1.3 League coordinator will develop a matrix to vote for the top 12.
 - 8.1.3 Any tie for the last position shall be broken.
- 8.2 From the 12 Person All-Conference team, one most valuable player shall be selected using a ballot. Each school shall have one vote and may vote for their own candidate.
- 8.3 Each school will be awarded two Second Team awards.
- 8 .4 No all-conference team shall be selected below the varsity level.

- 8.5 A ballot shall be taken to name the MVP. Each school shall have one vote to name the MVP from the 12 member All-Conference team. A school may vote for its own candidate
- 8.6 Each school shall receive 2 Second Team Positions.
- 8.7 Total Awards: Twelve (12) Type of Award: Patch and certificate.
- 8.8 All conference selections shall be forwarded to the league commissioner.
- 8.9 In the event a coach does not attend the All conference meeting.
 - 8.9.1 They may send a completed matrix form to the league coordinator. Their choices will be considered to the same degree as other schools.
 - 8.9.2 They will not be able to participate in any vote taken at the meeting.
