BY LAW - ARTICLE VII

LEAGUE AWARDS

Section 1 - League Awards for Each Sport

1.1 The number of All Conference awards for each sport are:

1.2 All ties must be broken. In no case may a sport exceed the allowed of all conference spots.

Section 2 - Special Awards

- 2.1 Each sport may have up to three special designation spots on the All Conference team (for example MVP, offensive player, designated hitter, etc.), if these awards are part of their sport bylaws. They must be selected from the number of all conference position allowed.
- 2.2 In any vote taken for one of the three special designation awards, schools will be permitted to vote for their own nominees.

Section 3 - Awards

- 3.1 Each All Conference designee shall receive a patch and certificate. Those selected as Second Team shall receive a certificate.
- 3.2 A pennant will be awarded to the school for a championship in any sport.
